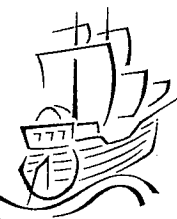


On behalf of the Nevada Childhood Cancer Foundation, I just wanted to take a moment and sincerely thank you so very much for your donation of \$20,000.00.
